This TikTok account has helped viewers improved their pronunciation skills while also providing a new perspective on English. TikTok account, @phoneticisfun, has videos teaching people the phonetic alphabets, beginning with a video that explained what the phonetic alphabets are and what they are used for. People are not only learn phonetics but also expand their vocabulary and learn how to pronounce new words.

1. INTRODUCTION

Speaking in English is already intimidating to second language learners (Ozdemir, E., & Papi, M., 2022) as they not only need to think of the grammar, but they also need to think of the correct pronunciation. Thus, to assist second language learners to speak English using the correct pronunciation, this project was developed. According to Priya, M. L. S., & Kumar, P. (2020), learning phonetics can enhance pronunciation in an English as Second Language classroom. With its personalised feeds of quirky short videos set to music and sound effects, the app is notable for its addictive quality and high levels of engagement.

In addition to adding filters, background music, and stickers to videos, amateur and professional creators can collaborate on content and create split-screen duet videos despite being at different locations.

You must be 18 years old or older, have at least 10,000 followers, and have at least 100,000 video views in the last 30 days to be paid by Tiktok. If this Tiktok account which is @phoneticisfun meet the requirements, then the account owner will be paid. Therefore, @phoneticisfun was promoted via various of social media platforms to increase the views.

2. METHODOLOGY

A market survey was created using Google Form to determine whether or not people are truly interested in learning the phonetic alphabets. The questions were all related to phonetics and their interest in learning phonetic alphabets via TikTok. The form was then distributed via social media platforms namely WhatsApp status, WhatsApp text and Instagram story to get responses. The Google form link was first shared with friends and family via WhatsApp text, but it did not receive much attention, so it was then shared on Instagram story and WhatsApp status.

While waiting for a response, a poster was created to attract the attention of users and pique their interest. A TikTok account was created to post videos of learning the Phonetic alphabets. To make the account more interesting, a profile picture was also created related to phonetics.

The project was then proceeded to recording and editing videos using the TikTok app and Cap cut app so the effects would be amazing and also to insert subtitles to make the videos more interesting and convenient for viewers to understand the content. 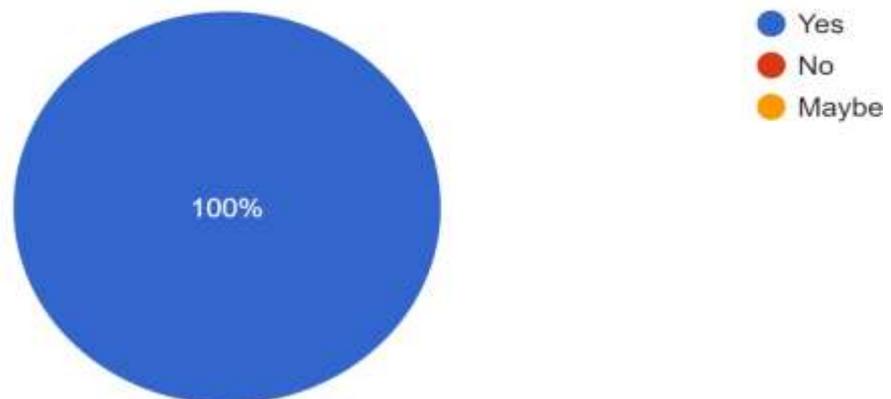


Figure 2. Interest

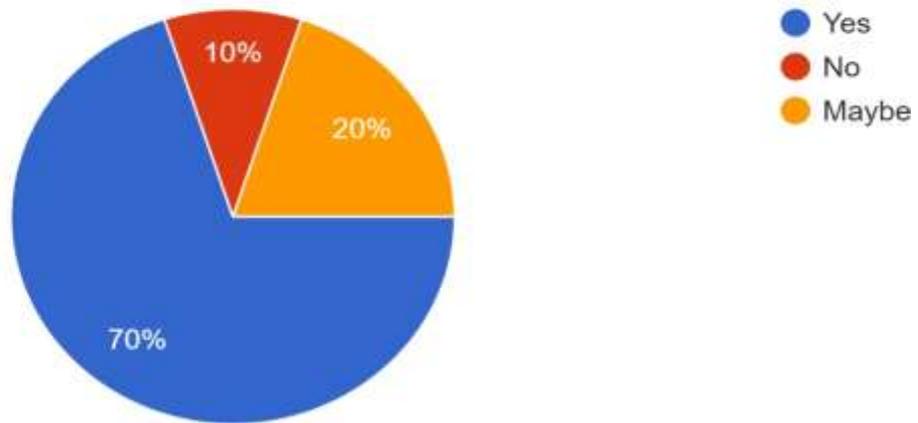


Figure 3. Problems in pronunciation
