Students will learn the general principles related to permanent and temporary exhibitions; organising and managing issues; handling of artworks; exhibition planning; space reservation; exhibition furniture and techniques; selection of artworks; captions and label writing; lighting and conservation measures; insurance; maintenance and security.
