ABSTRACT

UNI-ABODES is an innovative app specifically designed for university students to find a house or apartment to rent. With just a few taps on their smartphones, students can now browse through a wide range of housing options, compare prices and amenities, and connect with potential landlords or roommates. Students are having difficulty finding a place to live before the semester begins. Due to the limited space available in the hostel, they are compelled to find a place to rent outside of it. Aside from that, looking for house rentals can be a time-consuming procedure, and most students are clueless about where to look for rental housing. Our app's objective is to provide university students with a reliable and friendly platform to meet their requirements. The novelty of this app is that it is designed to be tailored to a specific user demographic, which is university students, by considering factors such as location, budget constraints, roommates' preferences, and proximity to campus. Besides, it caters to university students' requirements in Malaysia. This app significantly reduces the time and effort required by university students to find rental properties. Additionally, these apps allow students to focus more on their studies, and by accessing house rental apps, it can be a centralised platform to easily search and explore a wide range of rental listings. Finding adequate housing alternatives, particularly for university students, is one area where apps have had a huge impact. Finding a new home to live during the transition to college or university can be difficult and time-consuming. UNI-ABODES is the mobile application that helps the university students around Malaysia to find their rental house due to the lack of space provided by the hostel for the students to live at the time to save their finances. UNI-ABODES understands the unique requirements and challenges faced by students when searching for housing options, such as affordability, proximity to campus, and safety.

UNI-ABODES applications offer many features to the students in helping them find the ideal rental properties that they want. UNI-ABODES is very user-friendly for the first timer using the apps that allows students to easily search for available rental properties and navigate through various options. There are some features that UNI-ABODES offers, such as advanced search filters, where UNI-ABODES provides a menu to apply search filters. Students can apply search filters such as location, rent range, number of bedrooms, amenities, and lease period to identify properties that fit their needs. Students can also use the filters for selecting states and university campuses to find rental houses close to the campus. In addition, each rental listing on UNI-ABODES includes detailed property information, including descriptions, rental costs, amenities, floor plans, and high-resolution photographs. This enables students to learn about rental houses and make informed judgments before visiting or contacting property owners.

PROBLEM STATEMENT

When a new semester begins, most students will need to rent a house or a room because they did not get into a hostel. According to Sinar Daily (2002), university students who need to rent a house or room may encounter several specific problems such as limited budgets and distance from campus. Many university students have limited financial resources. They may need part-time jobs, student loans, or parental support to afford rent, especially in high-demand locations near institutions. Besides that, competition for housing is undeniably high as university towns often have a high demand for rental properties due to the student population. This can result in intense competition among students for limited available housing options, leading to increased rental prices and limited choices. Students who are staying in the room have to pay more than students staying in the living room. Moreover, some affordable housing options may be located far from the university campus, requiring students to commute long distances (Sinar Daily, 2022). This can impact their daily routine, study time, and involvement in campus activities.



Furthermore, when the house is too full, students find it impossible to concentrate due to the noise, but they can't afford to rent a bigger place.

OBJECTIVES

The objective of UNI-ABODES is to make the process of locating student housing easier by ensuring that students have access to affordable housing that is secure and pleasant so that they can focus on their studies while also reducing the amount of money they spend on housing. In addition, the purpose of this platform is to provide a user-friendly interface that simplifies the process of finding, renting, and managing accommodation for students. This will allow students to find a rental house that is reasonably priced and located near the university campus.

NOVELTY

There were various house and room rental applications that existed for the past few years such as Speedhome, iBilik and RoomHub. However, there were no applications that were specifically created to be accessed and used by university students. For students to use UNI-ABODES they were required to verify their student card since the student card was the only item that can be proof that they are still studying in universities. Therefore, UNI-ABODES strictly can be accessed by those students since this application was specifically targeted at university students. In addition, UNI-ADOBES was one of the applications that sorted all the nearest rental houses available around the users' university or campus. By using UNI-ABODES, students can choose a few types of house selection such as landed and high rise. There are also options available for students that only search for a room to rent. Users also can directly chat with the house owner to ask anything regarding the rental house. All the information including the price, specifications and the distance of the rental house or room from campus about the house were available in this application. Thus, this application was considered distinctive with other applications where they have their own point-of-parity. UNI-ABODES is a one-stop application for university students which helps and ease them to find and discover an affordable place to live while studying.

COMMERCIALIZATION POTENTIALS

According to Datin Paduka Dr Siti Hamisah Tapsir (2019), approximately 1.3 million Malaysian youths are pursuing tertiary education both in public and private universities. However, each university has a very limited space for their residential college which forces students to find their own rental house. Therefore, UNI-ABODES application is specifically



created for university students in Malaysia. Since UNI-ABODES was the first application that provided a rental house and room accommodations for university students, this application has the potential to cater all their target users to use this application in searching for a rental house. UNI-ABODES has the potential to be commercialized by considering the demand for student housing and integrating value-added services within the app that cater to the specific needs of university students, such as cleaning services and the use of Google Maps as a location search tool. Every section has various questions and starting from section B until D, the questionnaire is given and answered by using linear scales 1 to 5 that illustrates the



agreement to disagreement of respondents toward UNI-ABODES development.
