CHAPTER 1: INTRODUCTION

When our beloved ex-Prime Minister drops the idea of the National Service Program, the Minister has taken the action in making the program comes true by establishing a high-powered committee. The committee was headed by the Defence Committee Najib Tun Razak. After facing lots of opposing and a serious meeting about the implementation of the National Service Program in the Parliament, finally, the cabinet approved the pioneer batch of 100,000 18-year old youths, out of 480000 eligible, to begin the compulsory national Service for three months beginning early the year 2004.

CHAPTER 2: LITERATURE REVIEW

2.1 <u>Background of the National Service Program</u>

At the same time, this programme has received strong support from our Prime Minister, Dato Seri Dr. Mahathir Mohammad, who has warned that racial ties in multicultural Malaysia have weakens, particularly among young people. In Malaysia, the population of 23 million is made up 65 percent Malays and other indigenous groups, 26 percent ethnic Chinese and nearly eight percent ethnic Indians.
