# Raglan Mini Hat 1.0

at **UiTM CPP**

On December 2, 2023, the Ultimate Frisbee Club UiTM Pulau Pinang Branch (UiTM CPP) organised a tournament – Raglan Mini Hat (RMH) 1.0. To ensure the success of the event, a Frisbee Clinic had been conducted four weeks before the tournament which enabled the club to recruit participants for RMH 1.0. Through additional promotion via WhatsApp, RMH 1.0 received 47 registrations, including students from UiTM CPP, UiTM Perlis Branch, UiTM Perak Branch, Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP), Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM), Albukhary International University, and the public. While most participants

were experienced frisbee players, some inexperienced players were trained by the club players two weeks before the event.

The players were divided into four teams: red, blue, yellow, and black. Each player received a bandana in one of these colours to distinguish their teams. The tournament took place at the Basketball Court, UiTM CPP, starting at 8 a.m. and ending at 6 p.m. In the morning, after registration, participants were provided with breakfast to let them have enough energy to play. Before the game commenced, players engaged in warm-up exercises and received a briefing about the game from their respective team captains. The game flow resembled a FIFA football match in which the game began with each team competing until two teams received the highest scores. These top two teams advanced to the final game to determine the winner, while the remaining two teams with lower scores competed for the third and the fourth places.


