There are many factors that contributed to the road accident that is from the human error or attitude of the driver or motorcyclist itself. 2.1 INTRODUCTION

Malaysia once has been recognized as number one fatal highway in the world for 5 years on the roll since 1992 until 1996. The fact that has been stated in Laporan Khas Massa dated January 21, 1998 has showed the research that being made by the ESCAP or Economic and Social Committee of Asia Pacific. Based on the resources from Malaysian Road Safety Council (Majlis Keselamatan Jalan Raya Malaysia (MJKR)), the research from ESCAP was based on every 10,000 vehicles. The amount of the death in Malaysia is the highest in the world compared with Greece, which is in the second place for the highest death.

However, the number decreased slowly based on the research that being conducted by the **Faculty of Engineering in University of Putra Malaysia (UPM),** the rate of the death that causes by accident decreased to 4.9 deaths for the year 2002.
