Purchasing of the spare parts and delivery of the spare parts to the final customers are two of the major activities in EV-Shukmatec Engineering (M) Sdn. Bhd (EVS). The nature of business in this company is 'buy to sell'. Therefore, EVS will source the spare parts from suppliers and mark-up the price to be sold back to customers.
