Besides Department of Social Welfare, Childcare Center must get approval from Fire and Rescue Department, Land and Survey Department, Health Department and Local Council. The Childcare Center can be classified into two categories, which are Institution Based Childcare Center where there are more than ten children in care and Home Based Childcare Center where there there are less than ten children in care.
