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ABSTRACT

They lack character because they are generally composed of laminated particleboard and have a plain design. Most furniture producers care about the type of wood that goes into their creations, perhaps to draw attention to the priciest piece of wood. This article's goal is to put out a suggestion for how to construct a coffee table made of epoxy resin. This study is carried out to achieve the required objectives which to design an epoxy resin coffee table by using Casuarina equisetifolia slabs and the combination epoxy resin and metal, to produce an epoxy resin coffee table by using Casuarina equisetifolia slabs and the combination epoxy resin and metal and also to evaluate the user's satisfaction on knowledge, materials, and the design of the epoxy resin coffee table through questionnaire survey.
