#### ABSTRACT

According to Bank Negara Malaysia, our currency notes or banknotes must be changed every 12 years and it just has been introduced. Recently, on 2012 our country has introduced and launched new series of banknotes which we are using right now. These 4<sup>th</sup> series of Malaysia banknotes had made some improvement in terms of the material of the money and used less cost in order to produced it.
