1.0 PROBLEM STATEMENT

In the air freight industry, delivery on time plays a critical role in ensuring that the customers are satisfied with the services provided. In accepting goods for documentation, clearance and loading before flying off, the cargo handlers (Cargo Centre) should have a well planned and efficient system to allow for smooth flow in the processes.
