The Inaugural Audit Visit by the Ethics Review Committee Panel Auditor (EAP) from UiTM to the Faculty of Medicine Ethics Review Committee

The ERC Audit Panel, nominated by the Research Ethics Committee and appointed by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, conducted an audit on the FERC Faculty of Medicine.
