The Research Ethics Committee (REC) is an independent body responsible for overseeing the ethical conduct of human research at Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM). Their role is central to protecting the rights of research participants, specifically safeguarding their dignity, safety, and well-being, with particular attention given to vulnerable groups.

This REC workshop is an annual event that provides ongoing training aimed at equipping the full members of the REC with the necessary skills and a deeper understanding to address the increasing complexity of ethical review.
