CHAPTER ONE

INTRODUCTION

1.1 BACKGROUND OF STUDY

Cybercrime is a new computer crime of the century. This cybercrime consist of the elements of fraud , damage or modification of programs or computer data, theft of information , hacking, and more. Internet facilities should be used to make it easier for people to find information or to increase their knowledge.
