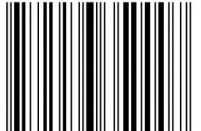

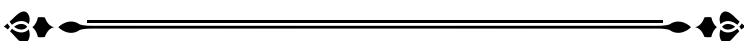
Being able to work with our team for the 30th edition of Alumni Homecoming Magazine is simply a blessing from the heavens.

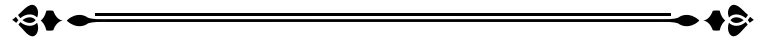

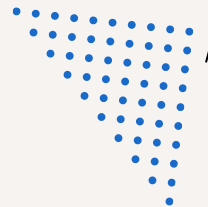

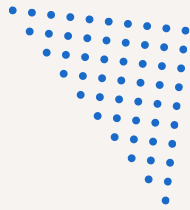

A special supper was arranged to commemorate the graduation of over 225 Teesside University students in Malaysia in 2017. Over 60 people from the area attended the event, which was

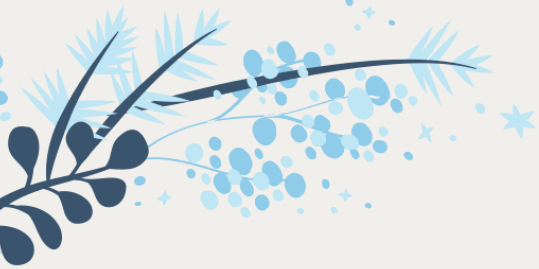
