

iTM Sabah, in partnership with Yayasan Peneraju and Yayasan Sukarelawan Siswa, is revolutionizing community development by focusing on economic empowerment in rural areas. Their recent initiative, a pioneering face-to-face basic entrepreneurial course, has set a new standard for fostering local

talent and sustainable growth. With 360 participants from five selected districts in Sabah, this program is a game-changer for community upliftment.

The program, held in Kundasang, Banggi, Matunggong, Keningau, and Semporna, targeted members of Kawasan Rukur Tetangga (KRT), including those involved in nano- and/or microbusiness activities as well as those exploring entrepreneurial opportunities. Training with the communities spanned over three days and two nights, offering an immersive experience tailored to each district's unique needs. With the assistance of Mr. Runiy Maldud, Head of Corporate Management, and the team at Yayasan Sukarelawan Siswa, this program was successfully conducted from Dec 11, 2023 to Jan 21, 2024.

The Program Pembangunan Ekonomi Komuniti (Peneraju Borneo) aims to level the playing field for underprivileged individuals in rural areas, especially the hardcore poor, B40, and

Additionally, participants gained valuable insights during an awareness talk on the importance of business registration, with representatives from local district offices present.

Upon completing the course, participants underwent a threemonth mentoring session led by mentors from UiTM Sabah, supplemented by online coaching sessions for continuous learning.





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
