At the beginning, Arkib Negara Malaysia was established on 12 January 1957 as a Public Record Office. Then, at year of 1963 this building was named as the National Archive of Malaysia. At year of 1966, State Archives Act No. 44 is approved and National Archive building in Petaling Jaya was inaugurated. At year of 1982, National Archives move to a new building in Jalan Duta, Kuala Lumpur. Then, at year of 2003, National Archives Act 2003 (Act 629) passed. At the year of 2004, National Archives of Malaysia is placed under the Ministry of Culture, Arts and Heritage.

Established on 12 January 1957 as a Public Record Office. The National Archive of Malaysia desire to mold a knowledgeable nation that values its national heritage, by acquiring, conserving, and preserving the national heritage.

The National Archives should become a national resource and Research Centre, that popularizes the archives and national heritage. Furthermore, the National Archives collect, procure and preserve records of national and historical value.
