

YB DATO' SRI HAJAH NANCY BINTI HAJI SHUKRI

Nancy was born on August 5, 1961, in Kuching, Sarawak, hails from Bibi McPherson and Shukri Mahidi as her parents. Her father's lineage comprises Malay and Melanau ancestry, while her mother's heritage encompasses Scottish, Iban, and Chinese roots. Presently residing in Kuching, Sarawak, Nancy is happily married with three children and she is the tenth child among eleven siblings. Following her victory in the 2008 Malaysian general election, She was graduated from Diploma in Public Administration Institute Teknologi Mara (1985), Bachelor's Degree in Law with honors in University Hull United Kingdom and Masters in Executive Business Administration in Ohio University in United State of America.

Nancy secured a parliamentary seat for Batang Sadong, a rural conservative constituency located in southern Sarawak state. Demonstrating her continued popularity, she successfully defended her seat in the subsequent 2013 Malaysian general election. Recognizing her abilities and dedication, then Prime Minister of Malaysia, Najib Razak, appointed Nancy as a Minister in the Prime Minister's Department in the newly formed Cabinet of Malaysia.



She was appointed as the Minister of Women, Family and Community Development. Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri from Parti Pesaka Bumiputera Bersatu Sarawak and currently holds the position of Minister of Tourism, Arts and Culture after being appointed in March 2020 as a Member of Parliament for Batang Sadong. She also held the portfolio of Minister of Plantation Industry and Commodity for a few months. In political involvement, she held the position of Assistant Secretary General of Sarawak United Bumiputera Women's Party, Secretary of Sarawak United Bumiputera Women's Movement and Secretary of the National Barisan Women's Movement.
