For the place where I went to industrial training, it is the department in UiTM Cawangan Negeri Sembilan Kampus Rembau. I went and and experience my industrial training at Bahagian Hal Ehwal Pelajar (BHEP). 


Figure 1. Organizational chart of UiTM cawangan Negeri Sembilan Kampus Rembau's Bahagian Hal Ehwal Pelajar
