1.0 INTRODUCTION

Background of Majlis Daerah Tanjong Malim

Establishment and Jurisdiction

The **Tanjong Malim District Council** was created on September 1, 1979, under the Local Government Act of 1976. It was formed by combining several smaller local councils to create a single, unified body to better manage the area. The council oversees several regions, including **Tanjong Malim**, **Slim River**, **Behrang**, and other smaller towns and villages in the southern part of **Perak**.

Geographical and Strategic Importance

Tanjong Malim is located near the border between the states of Perak and Selangor, making it an important center for both industry and education. The town is home to **Sultan Idris Education University** (UPSI), one of Malaysia's top educational institutions, which helps build its reputation as an education hub. Being close to major highways and railway lines also makes Tanjong Malim a key transit point between the northern and central parts of Peninsular Malaysia.

Roles and Responsibilities

The main duties of the **Tanjong Malim District Council** are urban planning, maintaining public infrastructure, managing waste, providing public health services, issuing licenses, and enforcing local laws. The council is essential in promoting sustainable development in the area by managing resources, improving public facilities, and enhancing the quality of life for its residents.
