The library services commenced with the establishment of Politeknik Merlimau in 2002. It is housed in a two-story building located in Block B, adjacent to the administration building, covering an area of 3,600 square meters. The library has a user capacity of 400 individuals.

The library employs the Library of Congress Classification (LCC) system for the organization and classification of its resources. LCC is widely recognized for its detailed and expansive subject coverage, making it suitable for academic and research libraries. This system ensures that library materials are systematically arranged and easily accessible to users, aligning with international standards for information organization. By using LCC, the library enhances its ability to provide users with a structured and efficient approach to retrieving resources.

Previously, the library utilized the ILMU system for its integrated library management. However, in late 2024, the library transitioned to the KOHA system, a globally recognized
