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CHAPTER 1: INTRODUCTION

1.1 BACKGROUND OF THE ORGANIZATION

1.1.1 History of Politeknik Merlimau

Politeknik Merlimau is the 14th polytechnic established by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia. It is located in the Jasin district, 2 km from the town of Merlimau, 24 km from Melaka city, and 19 km from Jasin town. The polytechnic began operations on November 17, 2002, and started admitting pioneer students in the second session of 2002, on December 23, 2002. The polytechnic has a maximum capacity of 5,060 students. Today, PMM is fully operational and has become an important nucleus for Merlimau. Since its establishment in 2002, Politeknik Merlimau has produced 21,580 graduates who are capable of contributing to the workforce.
