Currently serving as the Deputy Dean of Academic in Akademi Pengajian Bahasa, Associate Professor Dr Anealka Aziz Hussin has accumulated more than 20 years of experience working in UiTM. Her extensive experiences of serving in multiple departments in UiTM has qualified her to be where she is today. Dr Anealka has served as IT coordinator in APB for 2 years, worked in IPSIS for 2 years, in INED for 1 year, and she was the Head of Centre for the Intercultural Communication undergraduate programme (LG243) for 4 years.

Being in all those managerial positions for almost 10 years, it is no surprise that she was selected to become the Deputy Dean of Academic in APB now. Interviewing her up close and personal, it is clear that she has a vision and mission for APB.

When asked what was her best memory working in APB, she beamed and picked LG243's attainment of a 92% score from the external audit for IQA02. Her profile in the UiTM Expert website clearly shows that she has built a strong portfolio in corpus linguistics and technology. This is not a surprise as Dr Anealka has two Master's degrees: one in Educational Technology and another

one in Teaching English as Second Language (TESL). Talking about her degrees, she mentioned that she combined the knowledge that she gained from both of her master's

degrees to apply in innovation and research. To quote Dr Anealka directly, "I utilised the skills and knowledge that I have and put them into use".
