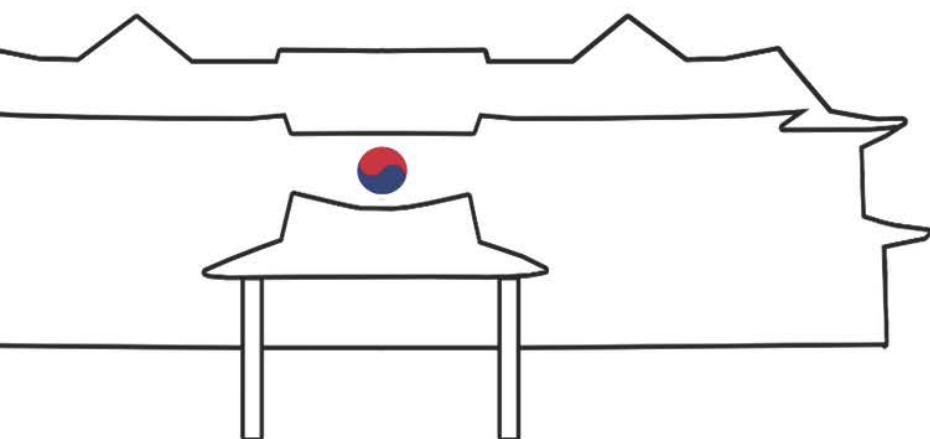

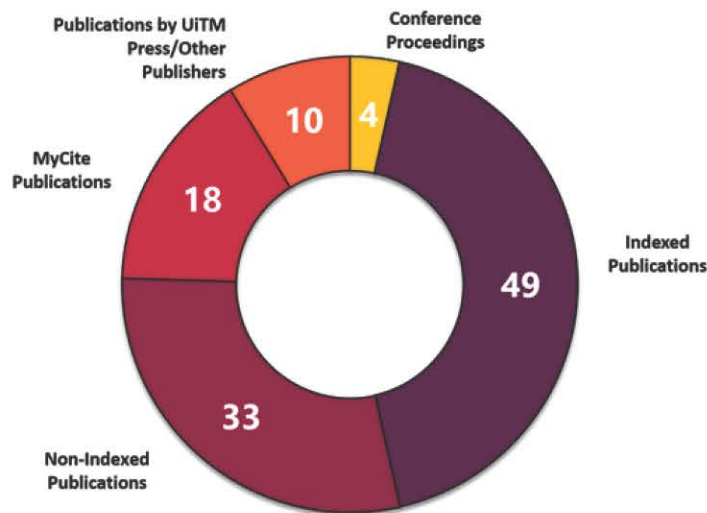

Number of Publications (APB) in 2022



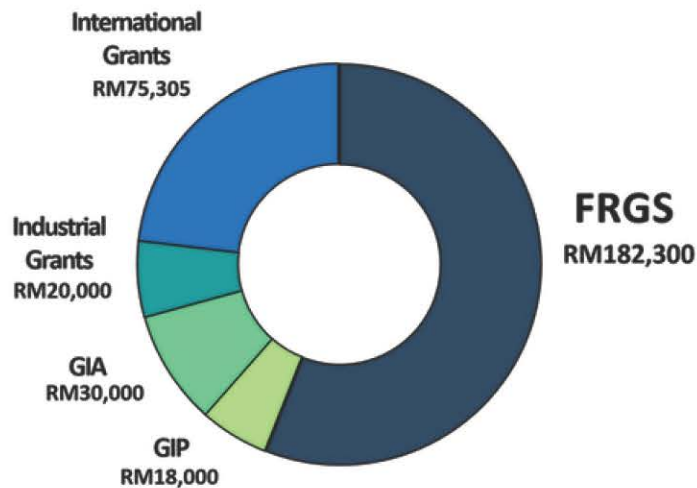

Scholarly publication is fundamental in advancing scientific knowledge and deemed as a vital contribution by academicians. Therefore, it is exciting to see APB lecturers actively exploring research opportunities and conducting academic investigations on diverse language-related issues.

As in the illustration, we have published a total of 49 articles in Scopus/WoS/ERA journals and 33 non-indexed publications. The number of MyCite publications by APB lecturers has also escalated this year (18 articles) as compared with 2021 (12 articles). The number of publications by UiTM Press or other publications also soared from 10 in 2021 to 16 in 2022. Furthermore, a notable growth is the number of conference proceedings (Scopus/WoS) as we recorded an increase of 4 publications.

These positive trends demonstrate that lecturers are espousing the broadening research culture in UiTM. We hope that our APB lecturers will continue to be proactive and strive to produce high-quality research for the advancement of knowledge and betterment of policies.

The first successful application is entitled 'A Creative Web-Based Instructional Model For Technology-infused Learning of Critical Academic Reading Skills Among ESL Undergraduates'. This 3-year grant was awarded RM114,100 and is led by Associate Professor Dr Anealka Aziz Hussin.

The second successful FRGS project is entitled 'A Novel Visual-Linguistic Model in Immunisation Brochures to Enhance Vaccination Intention Among Malaysian Youth.' This 2-year project was awarded RM68,200 and is led by Nadia Anuar.
