Associate Professor Dr Anealka Aziz Hussin, Associate Professor Dr Nor FazlinMohd Ramli, Dr Siti Aeisha Joharry, Dr Syamimi Turiman, Dr Mohammad Nor Afandi Ibrahim, Mr Ahmad Aminuddin Soopar, and Mr Adi Idham Jailani were delegates of APB, UiTM Shah Alam who participated in a discussion with delegates from University of Essex led by Prof. Anthony Foster, the Vice Chancellor of University of Essex. The meeting was held on 28th September 2022, and was also attended by delegates from UiTM Perak led by Professor Sr Dr Md Yusof Hamid.

Some of the main issues discussed during the meeting were 1) the proposal of progression route implementation for LG120 and LG240 students, which will provide opportunities for students to further their studies in University of Essex, 2) collaboration between APB's English Language Department and Pre-Sessional English Language (PEL) Department in University of Essex for



the purposes of benchmarking, language assessments, and development of teaching and learning materials, 3) collaboration of research and supervision for APB's postgraduates students, especially in the field of translation, and 4) internship opportunities for TESOL students from University of Essex to teach English language courses in UiTM. APB hopes that this discussion will expedite APB's strategy in facilitating the realisation of UiTM vision in becoming a globally renowned university
