At the time, the State Education Leader managed the education department in addition to acting as Chief Inspector and Head of the Terengganu State Post Office.
- Over the years, the location of JPNT has been changed frequently, up until 2000. The department is overseen by the Malaysian Ministry of Education, which is the primary government department responsible for education in the country. As JPNT has grown and developed, various sectors and divisions have been established to manage different aspects of education in the state. Among them are:
