The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization Regional Centre for Education in Science and Mathematics (SEAMEO RECSAM) was founded in July 1966 following a pivotal agreement among delegates from six SEAMEO countries during a Technical Workshop in Kuala Lumpur. Recognizing the urgent need to enhance the quality of science and mathematics education in the region, these educationists selected Penang, the Pearl of the Orient, as the Centre's location due to its conducive educational environment. Officially inaugurated in May 1967, SEAMEO RECSAM's mission is to improve teaching and learning in science and mathematics at the elementary and secondary levels. The Centre collaborates with national and regional teacher-training institutions to implement innovative programs aimed at developing a skilled, technically, and scientifically proficient workforce across Southeast Asia.

Key milestones in SEAMEO RECSAM's history include the approval of its first Five-Year Development Plan in 1969 and the commencement of its First Permanent Phase of Operation in July 1970. The Centre's state-of-the-art facilities were officially opened on 31 October 1977 by Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad, then Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Education Malaysia. SEAMEO RECSAM's logo, adopted in 1975, represents science, mathematics, and regional cooperation, reflecting the Centre's commitment to excellence and readiness for change. Today, SEAMEO RECSAM continues to play a vital role in fostering regional cooperation and elevating the standards of science and mathematics education, significantly contributing to the educational advancement and human resource development in Southeast Asia.
