Setting yet another rousing example, a team from the Academy of Language Studies, UiTM Sarawak comprising of Kimberly Lau, Jacqueline Susan Rijeng and Christine Jacqueline Runggol, as well as Michael Tiong from Regal City College, Kuching clinched a silver medal for their innovation called 'Listen Right'. Listen Right was created as an educational platform focusing on listening skills. Most importantly, this innovation is not only interesting and educational, but also accessible by all students no matter where they are and how their Internet connection is. The innovation was developed after considering the situation in Sarawak whereby most of the students who stay in the outskirts find it hard to get a fairly good Internet connection.

With online distance learning that was inevitable due to the Covid-19 pandemic, Listen Right aims to achieve three main objectives: 1) to create an interesting learning environment for students to learn listening, 2) to promote self-directed learning among students, 3) to produce a platform for both teachers and students to gain feedback on the success of the listening lesson.
