

On 15th September 2020, Rector, Professor Dato Dr Jamil Haji Hamali, paid a courtesy visit to YB Datuk Haji Abdul Karim Rahman Hamzah, Minister of Tourism, Arts and Culture Sarawak at his office located at Bangunan Baitulmakmur (MASJA). Also present at the meeting were Dr Ellen Chung and Dr Robin Chang.

The courtesy visit was to invite YB Datuk Haji Abdul Karim Rahman to witness the MoU signing between UiTM Sarawak and Professional Mutawwif Development Sdn Bhd, which was to be held on 30 September, 2020.

UiTM Sarawak will work together with Professional Mutawwif Development Sdn Bhd to offer Diploma in Mutawwif Professional and Muslim Tour Leader. According to Professor Dato Dr Jamil, this is one of Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) programmes offered by the university, and the modules are designed to focus on the quality of special needs in the Umrah industry as well as Islamic tourism in Malaysia.

During the meeting, YB Datuk Haji Abdul Karim Rahman was also informed and invited to attend the upcoming Special Edition of International Conference on Innovative Sciences and Technologies for Research and Education (InnoSTRE) on 25th to 26th November 2020. Sarawak Convention Bureau (SCB) has also pledged their support for the Conference.

UiTM Sarawak, led by Rector Professor Dato Dr Jamil Haji Hamali, paid a courtesy visit to the Chief Minister of Sarawak, Datuk Patinggi Dr Abang Abdul Rahman Zohari Tun Datuk Abang Openg on 16 November, 2020.

The purpose of the courtesy visit was to inform and invite the Chief Minister to officiate the Special Edition of International Conference on Innovative Sciences and Technologies for Research and Education (InnoSTRE) on November 25-26, 2020. UiTM Sarawak, together with ACEC Association and Anhui Medical University, China are the co-organisers of the Conference.

According to Conference advisor cum Rector of UiTM Sarawak, Prof Dato Dr Jamil Haji Hamali, InnoSTRE 2020 Special Edition was among the first few hybrid conferences in Malaysia that provides both virtual and physical platforms to discuss recent innovations and developments in science and technology in embracing the Covid-19 pandemic challenges.

The two-day conference featured several keynote speeches by notable figures from Malaysia, China, Thailand, Singapore and the Philippines. More than 80 papers were presented by local and international participants from 10 different countries.
