

Universiti Teknologi MARA is a partner of the project Erasmus+ Capacity Building for Higher Education: MSc. Food Processing and Innovation (FOODI) in a consortium of 16 partners led by Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM). Rolling into the second year of the project, the unprecedented Covid 19 Pandemics have prevented a travelling plan to Kuala Lumpur for seven participants from UiTM Sarawak funded by the ERASMUS + programme to attend a course on FOODI Academic Staff

Training. Instead a Webinar Series for Training of Trainer (ToT) in Food Processing and Innovation was conducted from August 3, 2020 to August 14, 2020. This Webinar Series was based on sixteen (16) short sessions of one and a half hour, each led by the European partners namely University College of Dublin Ireland that focused on Design Thinking while aspects of Active Learning were shared by University of Salerno, Italy and University of the Aegean, Greece.

This course aimed to build the skills, knowledge and expertise of the FOODI Consortium Partner Higher Education Institutions based in Malaysia, Cambodia and Thailand by transferring of experience and good practices from the FOODI EU Higher Education Institutions (University College Dublin, University of Salerno and University of Aegean). It focused on active learning and teaching & learning methodologies used by the FOODI EU Higher Education Institutions as a systemic means of developing & delivering new courses. It was structured into four sections:

Section 2: Additional examples of active learning

Section 3: Interactive and Active Learning Tools and Methodologies in Business Modules
Section 4: MIDAS Course
