

PHARMAFIESTA 2025

PharmaFiesta 2025, organised by the Society of Pharmacy Students (SOPHYS) at Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) Puncak Alam, was a two-part event aimed at promoting creativity, cultural appreciation, and unity among pharmacy students. This year's programme included two main highlights: Cultural Day and PharmaDreamy Night, showcasing both cultural pride and student performance.

Cultural Day was held on 18 June 2025, from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., and was conducted entirely online through Google Form and Instagram Story. The event encouraged students to wear traditional attire representing Malaysia's multicultural identity. Participants submitted a photo of themselves in traditional clothing via Instagram Story and a Google Form to enter the "Best Traditional Attire" contest. Outfits such as baju kurung, cheongsam, saree, and batik were proudly worn by students, showcasing cultural diversity and elegance. Four winners were selected: Nuralifah Insyirah binti Mohamed Zain (RX21), Alya Salwa binti Roslini (RX22), Enjuvivila Ve Ennos Ve, and Nur Liyana binti Mahadi (RX23), each recognised for their stunning traditional presentation.





PharmaDreamy Night took place on 21 June 2025, from 7:25 p.m. to 10:30 p.m., at DK500, featuring theatrical performances from each student batch. The event was directed by Nur Izzaty binti Affendy and supervised by advisor Pn. Massita Nordin. Each performance reimaged a Disney classic by incorporating local cultural elements, resulting in four captivating performances: RX20 performed Aladdin and The Magic Lamp, RX21 presented Beauty and the Beast, RX22 showcased Tangled, and RX23 staged Cinderella. The performances provided students with valuable opportunities to strengthen their teamwork, build confidence, and express creativity.

Two judges from the Faculty of Accountancy evaluated the performances based on the specific criteria, including storyline, creativity, emotional delivery, teamwork, stage presence, and audience engagement. RX23 was awarded Performance of the Night for their impressive version of Cinderella. Individual awards were determined through audience voting conducted via a QR-linked Google Form. Aliff Zulkarnain bin Zani (RX20) and Tengku Nur Firas Ain Tengku Khairi (RX21) won Best Actor and Best Actress, respectively. Meanwhile, Best Dressed awards were given to Nur Zameel Hadif bin Nor Azman (RX23) and Aina Nafisah binti Ahmad Nazeri (RX22) for their creativity and attire that matched the event's theme. PharmaFiesta 2025 successfully promoted leadership, patriotism, and cultural appreciation among pharmacy students.
