he World Puppet Carnival organized by the Ministry of Culture and Tourism of Malaysia and the State of Sarawak was held in Kuching from 2nd to 8th November 2015. The best puppet production team for theatre, video and film consisted of not only Malaysian puppeteers but also those from all over the world such as Argentina, Japan, Finland, Australia, Singapore, the Philippines, Bulgaria, Turkey, Belgium, France, Algeria, USA, Kazakhstan, Guatemala, Liberia, Canada, Russia, Colombia, Belarus, and Poland. On 3rd November 2015, the puppeteers joined by novices from various schools, institutions of higher learning and members of the public making a total of 391 puppeteers made it to the Malaysia Book of Records (MBOR) for having the most puppets in a single show at the Spring Department Store. Almost half of these novices were students from the Faculty of Plantation and Agrotechnology and Faculty of Arts and Designs led by En Clement ak Jimel. They achieved this feat at The Spring Shopping Mall in the presence of MBOR director Christopher Wong, guest-of-honour Senator Datuk Dr Sim Kui Hian and Sarawak Artist Society member Gerald Goh, who assisted in bringing in these puppeteers.
