The tour offered a concise yet comprehensive overview of university hospital pharmacy services under Malaysia's Ministry of Education. At the Logistics Pharmacy Unit, the students learnt about inventory management systems, including cold chain logistics for temperature-sensitive medications. In the Inpatient Pharmacy Department (IPD), they observed workflows from prescription screening to ward supply, as well as pharmacist interventions. The cleanroom for cytotoxic drug preparation showcased safety and handling protocols, while the Outpatient Pharmacy highlighted automated conveyor systems that enhance dispensing efficiency and ensure patient safety.

The visit concluded in the hospital auditorium with a presentation on HASA's pharmaceutical services by Mr. Hafidz and Mr. Nur Azmi Badarulzaman, followed by a lively Q&A session. This first-hand exposure to Malaysia's clinical pharmacy environment underscored the importance of adaptability, cultural exchange, and professional collaboration in preparing future pharmacists for global healthcare challenges.
