3MT® COMPETITION

The annual 3 Minute Thesis or 3MT® competition was conducted between 5th to 13th April 2022. This competition was once again held virtually by the Faculty of Medicine in conjunction with the Institute of Postgraduate Studies (IPSiS), UiTM. The 3MT competition is a highly engaging presentation by Ph.D. students. It challenges them to convey their respective research projects in an appropriate language to a non-specialist audience within three minutes. All active Ph.D. research students who have completed their proposal defense but not the viva-voce are eligible to participate.

The Faculty's Postgraduate Office received a total of 14 submissions, and the videos were judged by a panel of 3 judges, including Dr. Choy Ker Woon (First Runner-up, National 3MT® 2019); Dr. Muhammad Fairuz Azmi (First Prize Winner UiTM 3MT® 2019 and Faculty's 3MT® trainer since 2020); Dr. Norhafiza Razali (Second Runner-up 3MT® UiTM, 2015 and Faculty's 3MT® trainer since 2016). On 13th April 2022, the panel of judges, together with Deputy Dean (Postgraduate & Professional Training), Prof. Dr. Rohana Abdul Ghani, deliberated to determine the top three winners.

The three winners were announced on the 13th of April afternoon, and these 3 will represent the faculty for the upcoming UiTM 3MT® competition on 21st April 2022. The first prize winner was Norazirah binti Mat Nayan, first runner-up was Nur Adilla binti Zaini, and the third runner-up was Mohamad Wafriy bin Che Ismail. These three talented researchers were trained for the UiTM 3MT® by the judging panel and Mr. Afiqq Aiman, the faculty's MD990 student who was the Malaysia representative for the Asia Pacific 3MT® Competition 2021. The grand prize winner of the UiTM 3MT® Competition will represent UiTM for the National 3MT Competition, held on 28th June 2022
