Post-Flood Relief Programme by Faculty of Applied Sciences (FSG), UiTM Shah Alam

Faculty of Applied Sciences (FSG), UiTM Shah Alam organised a post-flood relief programme for all FSG staff who were affected by the worst floods in Selangor from 18 to 22 December 2021. The downpours since Friday, 17 December 2021 had led to the overflowing of rivers, submerging many areas, damaging houses, cutting off main roads, and affecting the provision of essential services such as water, food, and health.

FSG took a swift action to help FSG flood victims through providing much-needed aid including post-flood clean-up and donations. This programme was the initiative of FSG management team led by the Dean, Prof. Dr Farida Zuraina Mohd Yusof, to provide post-flood cleaning assistance and donations. An email announcement calling for donation was sent out by the Dean, on 21 December 2021 had given ample time until 24 December 2021 at 3 pm before the distribution could be made. The total donation collected from staff, retirees and FSG alumni was RM14,230, and additional funds were also obtained from FSG Trust Fund of RM6,000 making the accumulated fund amounting to RM20,230. Out of the total, RM500 was distributed to each affected FSG staff. The contribution of RM500 was distributed through online transfers to academic staff bank account, whilst the distribution of food and RM500 cash were given to administrative and laboratories staff.

Apart from the donations, the FSG team had also provided post-flood cleaning assistance at homes of affected staff. A total of 43 FSG staff were affected by the huge losses due to damaged property in the massive floods that hit Selangor. However, four of them had returned the funds to enable a large amount that could be donated to the more severely affected FSG staff.
