Prof. Dr Sulaiman Shaari, from School of Physics & Materials Studies, Faculty of Applied Sciences, Shah Alam, who is also the Secretary-General of the Asian Photovoltaic Industry Association (APVIA), had organised and conducted an international event of the Global Solar Council (GSC) and hosted by APVIA on 13 October 2021. The GSC is the world's solar energy industry, a non-profit body based in Washington D.C., representing national, regional and international associations and leading solar sector corporations.

The APVIA is an organisation registered in Singapore, consisting of PV enterprises, scientific institutions and relevant bodies in Asian countries under voluntary enrolment. The scope of the association covers information and academic exchange, technical consultation, project demonstration, quality standards, market service, education and training.

The Solar International Dialogue gathered experts from around the world and focused on the direction of PV technology for South-East Asia (SEA). Speakers and participants came from ASEAN member states, Australia, Europe and China. Key takeaways of this event are sharing of information on the organics of PV trends, pragmatic policies on the migration to sustainable energy, markets, education, technology and areas of applications for the SEA region.
