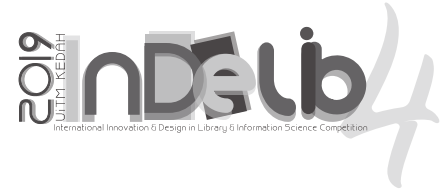

ABSTRACT:
