Putrajaya or the full name of the Federal Territory of Putrajaya is the administrative center of the Federal Government of Malaysia that replaced Kuala Lumpur in 1999 and the administrative capital of Malaysia. Putrajaya is a smart capital in a park located 25 kilometers south of Kuala Lumpur is a futuristic city that houses the administrative center of the Federal Government. It is the 3rd Federal Territory in Malaysia.

Its location in the middle of the Multimedia Highway Corridor, Putrajaya with an area of 4,931 hectares was developed at a cost of RM20.5 billion containing the Federal Government Administration Center, Housing, Commercial facilities, social facilities and religious facilities.

On 10 May 1999, the Prime Minister's Office Complex began operating in Putrajaya. Putrajaya is a benchmark for the development and administration of a city both at the domestic and international levels.

1.2 BUILDING BACKGROUND

1.2.1 BUILDING HISTORY

The Kompleks Islam Putrajaya is an administrative building complex for Malaysian government agencies located in the federal administrative center, Putrajaya Federal Territory. The Kompleks Islam Putrajaya is located in Precinct 3, Putrajaya and features modern Islamic architecture. It consists of four blocks namely Block A, B, C and D. It was inaugurated on 18 July 2017 by the Prime Minister of Malaysia, Dato' Seri Mohd Najib Tun Abdul Razak.

Kompleks Islam Putrajaya was built in October 2011. Construction was completed in July 2016 and began operations on 1 December 2016. The Kompleks Islam Putrajaya office block was built by TH Properties on a 2.21hectare site. Putrajaya Islamic Complex design is inspired by modern Islamic architecture. The complex houses nine religion agencies under the portfolio of Religious Affairs, the Prime Minister's Department. Blocks A, C and D are connected by a flyover that is on the second floor of each. T'e building also has an underground auditorium and can accommodate about 773 people.

The Kompleks Islam Putrajaya plays a significant role as a landmark and continuation of the glory of Islamic administration. By centralizing religious agencies in one complex, the government's desire to improve service delivery to the people will be enhanced. Islamic affairs such as halal certificate applications, Hajj and Umrah affairs, Islamic financial and banking services and Islamic family matters can be delivered to customers more easily and quickly.
