The 5th International Symposium of Language & Arts Education (iSOLA) 2024 was successfully held at the Faculty of Languages, Arts and Culture, Yogyakarta State University, Indonesia. The launch ceremony was officiated by Dr. Hasnul Faizal Hushin Amri, Director of Malaysian Education in Indonesia, Malaysian Embassy in Jakarta.

The event was also attended by distinguished guests, Prof. Dr. Sharipah Ruzaina Syed Aris, Dean of the Faculty of Education UiTM; Prof. Dr. Nur Hidayanto, Dean of the Faculty of Languages, Arts and Culture, Yogyakarta State University (UNY); and Prof. Dr. Phil Yudi Sukmayadi, Dean of the Faculty of Arts and Design Education, Indonesian University of Education (UPI).

iSOLA 2024, themed "Cultural Locality and Global Creativity," aimed to celebrate cultural exploration and educational research in the fields of art, language, and culture from Malaysia and Indonesia. Faculty of Education, Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM), Yogyakarta State University (UNY), and the Indonesian University of Education (UPI) are co-organizers, with support from collaborative partners including University of Malaya, Sultan Idris Education University (UPSI), Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (UNIMAS), Malaysian Arts School, Selangor Arts Foundation, Shah Alam Gallery, and the Teacher Education Institute.

In conjunction with iSOLA's decade celebration, various interesting activities were arranged including academic symposiums, art talk workshops and forums, art and innovation exhibitions, education and cultural carnivals, and community

service programmes. The highlight of the event was the Signing Ceremony of various cooperation agreements, including Memorandums of Understanding (MoU), Memorandums of Agreement (MOA), and Letters of Intent (LoI) between UiTM and involved institutions, including SMK Negeri 5 Yogyakarta and Bima Bakti Yogyakarta Foundation for Islamic Boarding Schools and Orphanages. It is hoped that iSOLA 2024 can be fully utilized by all parties involved, thus contributing to the development of competent and skilled educational institutions in the fields of language, arts, and cultural education. This effort aligns with ASEAN's aspiration to enhance the sustainability of quality and competitiveness of education in the region to ensure the continuity of shared cultural heritage in the era of globalization.





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
