INTRODUCTION TO WTK IMBOK ENTERPRISE SDN. BHD.

Imbok Enterprise is part of WTK Holdings Berhad in term of agribusiness industry, WTK Holding has overall 16 Estate in Sarawak which Imbok Enterprise is one of it, Total hectares of this estate are 10,610.85 Ha and Imbok are the largest estate among others estate of WTK Holding Berhad. Imbok Enterprise. Imbok Enterprise are located at Kemena Land & Suai Land District, Bintulu. Hectares are divided into :

1. Office, Compound, Quarters and Oil Mill Site - 66.63 Ha
2. Main Roads - 177.52 Ha
3. Buffer Zone, Terrain IV Area - 57.70 Ha
4. Ponds - 17.90 Ha

INTRODUCTION TO WTK AGRIBUSINESS (OIL PALM)

As a progressive conglomerate, WTK is steadily diversifying into oil palm plantation. To-date, the total plantation land bank of group (excluding public listed WTK Holdings Berhad) stands at approximately 70,000 hectares, spread out and located in different parts of Sarawak, out of which 40,000 hectares are fully planted and in production of Fresh Fruit Bunches (FFB). WTK Holdings Berhad owns 25,000 hectares of land bank for oil palm plantation which is still under the development phase.

WTK group also owns three oil-mills with a total production capacity of 130 metric tone of FFB per hour. At present, the annual total production is expected to be better with the larger matured acreage. WTK's palm oil operations have contributed substantial cash flow to the group over the years. To synergise and consistent with the group expansion programme and downstream development for higher-value addition of oil palm products, WTK group is planning to move into oil palm refinery in the near future.
