## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

In 2000, the Golden Hope Company change their crop again into oil palm and at the Nov 2007 Sime Darby start to operate until now. Sime Darby Melalap estate are divided into 2 division. First is Main division with area 831.72 and second is Pegalan Division with area 509.86. Since from the first oil palm crop are planted, this year at Pegalan division they are replanting that area again and during our internship the age of the seedling almost 6 months already.
