
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ABSTRACT

The aims of this study was to investigate students' motivation and attitude toward the learning of English language; to investigate students English language achievement and its component of listening, speaking, reading and writing and to determine the relationship between students' motivation and attitude toward their English language achievement. Comprising 329 randomly selected sampling for both Social Science and Science & Technology programme in UiTM Dungun, the study reveal that although students have a moderately high motivation and attitude towards English language learning, thus English language achievement attainment was low. The study also reveals that SES plays a significant role in English language learning and achievement. Students from high SES have a higher attainment in motivation, attitude and English language achievement as compared to their counterparts from lower SES. It is important for the government and policymakers to look into these matters on educational processes and provide equal education opportunities for those who are in need.

ABSTRAK

Kajian ini bertujuan untuk menyiasat motivasi dan sikap pelajar terhadap pembelajaran bahasa Inggeris; untuk menyiasat pencapaian pelajar dalam pembelajaran Bahasa Inggeris di dalam komponen komponen mendengar, bertutur, membaca dan menulis dan untuk menentukan hubung kait antara motivasi dan sikap pelajar terhadap pencapaian bahasa Inggeris mereka. Seramai 329 pelajar secara rawak telah dipilih untuk tujuan kajian ini yang terdiri dari pelajar Sains Social dan Sains & Teknologi. Hasi kajian menunjukkan para pelajar mempunyai kadar motivasi yang tinggi untuk mempelajari Bahasa Inggeris tetapi sebaliknya keputusan pencapaian mereka rendah dan tidak setanding dengan kadar motivasi mereka. Selain dari itu, hasil kajian juga membuktikan taraf kehidupan sosial (SES) begitu mempengaruhi daya motivasi dan sikap para pelajar terhadap pembelajaran dan pencapaian Bahasa Inggeris. Para pelajar dari taraf kehidupan sosial (SES) yang tinggi mempunyai tahap motivasi, sikap dan pencapaian yang tinggi di dalam pembelajaran Bahasa Inggeris berbanding mereka yang dari SES yang rendah. Dari hasil kajian ini, adalah disyorkan bahawa kerajaan dan pihak yang bertanggung jawab dapat memberi bantuan kewangan dan sebagainya kepada pelajar dari golongan SES yang lebih rendah agar jurang pencapaian pelajar di antara SES dalam bidang bahasa Inggeris dapat dikurangkan.
