ABSTRACT

It is a known fact that for motorcyclist, a head protection is the most important piece of safety equipment to prevent yourself from getting much more worse injuries in an accident. Malaysians are found to have lack of self safety awareness moreover for the safety of the people that they love. This study goes some way in addressing the issue and suggesting a solution pertaining to the matter.
