ABSTRACT

Construction site is a place specially prepared to carry out activities of a project. Construction site is a place that has the potential to occur any accident or minor accidents such as slipping or injury. To make sure labour management at construction site is carried out accordance to legal requirement or not, an assessment was conducted to five case studies in Kuala Lumpur and Shah Alam.
