Biofuel production can be categorized into biodiesel and bioethanol. Bioethanol is one alternative for transport fuel substitution. The most common renewable fuel today is ethanol derived from sugar. Besides that, future large-scale use for ethanol will most certainly have to be based on production from lignocellulosic materials. This review gives on overview of the new technologies of biotransformation on paddy straw into bioethanol. Rice straw have lignocellulosic material for bioethanol production since it is one of the most abundant renewable resources.
