# THE COMPARISON OF CONVENTIONAL AND DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY AS A MEDIUM OF CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATION

**Statement of Problem**: The problem of this research is the use of new implementation of Digital camera in police investigation, where digital camera is different from the conventional camera. By using the digital camera, the heavy task of forensic photographer becomes simple. While many of them knew about the advantage of using the digital camera, most of them doesn't even know that the image from the digital camera can arose suspicion among administrative of justice (Prof Dr Akram 2010). They did not realize that the same issue which haunted the conventional method regarding the image authentication, will also happening the digital camera for the purpose to differentiate which of the images can enhance and smoothen the investigation works.

**Procedures:** The researcher has chosen two techniques, namely the interview and observation to collect data. Survey interview were distributed to 11 respondents from 4 groups. The respondent consists of the specialist in investigation, legal law, scholar and photographer.

**Finding:** Based on the responses from the respondents, it is clear that law enforcement must totally implement the digital camera in their investigation to replace conventional camera. The issue of manipulation of the image from the digital camera can be solved if they established a clear procedure and become transparent with it. In order to ensure that the implementation process is smooth and give a positive impact, a solid preparation must be made.

**Conclusion:** The implementation of digital camera in the PDRM's investigation will be seen as a good step in enhancing the investigation. Even though there is a number of weaknesses that can be identified by using this type of camera, it doesn't mean that it is severe. Generally, the application of
