ABSTRACT

This paper aim at finding out the impact of macroeconomic variables towards economic growth in Malaysia which the export is monitor based on the Export Rate. The variables are considered are exchange rate (ER), foreign direct investment (FDI), economic growth (GDP), unemployment (UNP)), and inflation (CPI). This study required 50 years data which is from 1967 until 2017. Methodology used for this study is using Multiple Linear Regression with series data. Thereafter, econometric test is to be conducted to observe the relationship of the independent variables with export.
