Professor Tan Sri Dato' Dzulkifli Abdul Razak has been at the helm of Universiti Sains Malaysia as its Vice-Chancellor since 2000, besides being appointed as Chair of the Malaysian Vice-Chancellors'/Rector's Committee. He was formerly the President of Association of Southeast Asia Institutions of Higher Learning (ASAIHL), and is presently serving on various committees internationally including Asia-Europe Meeting (ASEM) Education Hub Advisory Committee, Association of Commonwealth Universities (ACU), and more recently, the International Association of Universities (IAU) - a UNESCO-affiliated organization, as its Vice-President. He was also a member of the Advisory Committee of World Universities Forum, Davos, 2008. He has served on the World Health Organization (WHO) Expert Advisory Panel on Drug Policies and Management since 1995, and the WHO Scientific Advisory Committee on Tobacco Product Regulation (2000-2002). He is a Fellow of the Malaysia Academy of Science, and the World Academy of Art and Science. He has regularly contributed to a leading Malaysian daily, as a weekly columnist, since 1995 for NST, and more recently since 2008, for The Edge, a business weekly, writing on issues relating to education, science and current events.
