

# **Pseudophylline Bushcrickets from Pahang in the Repository of the Natural History Museum, London and Zoologisches Museum Hamburg, Germany (Orthoptera: Tettigoniidae: Pseudophyllinae)**

## **ABSTRACT**

*The Pseudophylline bushcrickets from Pahang which are reposed in Natural History Museum, London and Zoologisches Museum Hamburg, Germany are represented. A total of 5 species under 5 genera were recorded from Pahang, Malaysia. The species were Cratioma oculatum Karny, Pseudophyllus hercules (Karny), Onomarchus cretaceus (Serville), Morsimus quadratus quadratus (Rehn) and Typhoptera quadriflora (Westwood).*

## **Introduction**

The systematics of the Tettigoniidae from Peninsular Malaysia was started by Stal (1874) who described 3 species (*Phygela haanii* Stal, *Elbenia nigrosignata* Stal and *Psyra melanonota* Stal) from Malacca. It was followed by Brunner (1878, 1895) and Hebard (1922). Since then, a number of species were described or recorded from Peninsular Malaysia (Karny 1923, 1926; De Jong 1939, 1960; Beier 1954, 1962; Heller 1995; Muzamil 1997, 2000, 2001a, 2001b; Muzamil & Mohamed Said 1998). The subfamily Pseudophyllinae and Conocephalinae was last revised by Beier (1962) and Karny (1907), respectively.

This paper presents the Pseudophylline bushcrickets from Pahang which are reposed in the Natural History Museum, London and

Zoologisches Museum Hamburg, Germany. A total of 5 species under 5 genera were recorded from Pahang, Malaysia. The species are *Cratioma oculatum* Karny, *Pseudophyllus hercules* (Karny), *Onomarchus cretaceus* (Serville), *Morsimus quadratus quadratus* (Rehn) and *Typhoptera quadrituberculata* (Westwood).

## Materials and Methods

### Materials

The materials used in this study were Pseudophyline bushcrickets (Orthoptera: Tettigoniidae: Pseudophyllinae).

### Examination

Institutions in which the materials were examined and reposed are abbreviated as follows:

ZMH – Zoologisches Museum Hamburg, Germany.

### Identification

Identification is based on Beier (1954, 1962) and Karny (1923, 1926).

## Results and Discussion
