ABSTRACT

Community safety is a concept that is concern to achieve a positive state of well-being among people within social and physical environments. This research aim is to evaluate the factors influencing of crime in neighbourhood community. The objectives of this study is; i. to study the elements of CPTED, ii. to identify the factors influencing of crime in neighbourhood community and iii. to propose recommendation for the elements of CPTED in neighbourhood community. This research is based on data gathering from survey questionnaire regarding the factors influencing of crime in neighbourhood community. The questionnaire involves 50 respondents to answer.
